WHEREAS, the North Shore State Snowmobile Trail is a multiple use trail; and  
WHEREAS, the use of the North Shore State Trail (NSST) for All-Terrain-Vehicles (ATV) would minimize the additional loss of forest and recreation land if a separate trail was created for ATV's; and

WHEREAS, much of the NSST is located on St. Louis County Tax Forfeit Land and it is the policy of the St. Louis County Board of Commissioners to encourage public recreational use of roads and trails that cross these lands; and

WHEREAS, the authorized use of the NSST for ATV use would concentrate use on an improved trail which would minimize land disturbances on other unimproved trails and accesses on public and private lands; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the St. Louis County Board of Commissioners supports the concept to use the North Shore State Trail for ATV use.
